Players & Umpires

Accessing the Venue

- The perimeter of the event space will be fenced this year providing one check in point for staff to collect information of those entering to assist with contract tracing if necessary.
- Players and umpires must show their MyNetball email receipt of registration & photo ID on arrival each day.
- To access the MyNetball receipt follow the following instructions:

OR Log into MyNetball (using your email and password)

- Click on the Activity menu
- Click on Purchases
- You will then see 2 tabs – under My Purchases – you will see your NetFest Team Join –
- We recommend taking a screen shot on your phone for easy access – if you don't have your phone – you will need to bring a printout of the proof of your registration.
- Players and umpires will be given a “wrist-band” on arrival to be worn on their wrist (please ensure it is fitted to your wrist and there is no gap – ie a finger cannot fit between your wrist and band). A new color “wrist-band” will be provided each day.
- Once players and umpires have received their “wrist-band”, they will be permitted to exit and re-enter via the exit points throughout the day.
- Players and umpires are asked to allow time to enter through the check in point.

Once Inside the Venue

Players

- **Player areas** will be marked on the ground and umbrellas provided for shade in each area. These will be offered as a first in first served basis. Please adhere to the social distancing requirements in this area.
- **Team registrations** we ask 1 person per team checks in upon arrival at the Netball Office.

Umpires

- Make your way to the Umpire Marquee (refer map).

Hygiene & Safety Measures

- **Hygiene** please ensure you wash / sanitise your hands regularly throughout the event and prior to every match you play or umpire.
- **Sanitiser stations** will be set up around the event site.
- Social distance 1.5 metres
 - when entering and exiting the court
 - when spectating
 - adhere to the max capacity allowance in smaller areas (follow signage information)
- **Seating areas** – there will be no shared seating areas, you are welcome to bring your own chairs.
- **Cleaning** – regular cleaning will take place please be patient if you are slightly inconvenienced by this.
- **Match equipment** – umpires will perform regular cleans on the match equipment hourly (goal post pad, ball, scoreboard & pen).

Symptoms

- If you are feeling unwell, please stay home.
- If you become unwell at the event, please notify the nearest event staff member, security or seek medical assistance at the first aid tent immediately.
- If you are showing flu like symptoms event staff have the right to refuse entry to the event.

- A limited number of spectators (200) will be allowed to enter for the All Stars Netball Match on Thursday 26th November this will be on a first in first served basis.
- Gates will open for spectators at 3:30pm with the match commencing at 5:30pm.
- All spectators will be required to check in and check out via QR code.
